OBEDIENCE TITLE

PREP

- EXAM** Demonstrate that your dog will allow an exam. Show yourself running your hand from neck to tail and down leg. Show they are comfortable and not struggling.
- SIT** Demonstrate that your dog can sit on cue.
- DOWN** Demonstrate that your dog can down on cue.
- STAY** Demonstrate that your dog can stay Stay for 5 seconds. Handler will cue the Stay and go to end of the leash for 5 seconds. then return to dog.
- RECALL** Demonstrate that your dog can come when called.
- WATCH ME** Demonstrate that your dog can keep focus on you with "Watch me" for at least 5 seconds.
- MANNERS** Demonstrate that your dog can Wait at doorway or a crate doorway for release before continuing on.
- LOOSE LEASH** Demonstrate that your dog can walk on a Loose Leash for at least 30ft. Leash must remain loose.

Treats and Toys may not be visible to the dog. No luring is allowed. You may reward after each trick.
Videos can be edited together from clips. Submit via the FB or Email a video link.

OBEDIENCE TITLE

PRIMARY

- GROOMING** Demonstrate that your dog allows grooming comfortably. Show brushing & handling of feet or nail trim.
- EXAM** Demonstrate that your dog allows an exam. Show yourself running a hand from neck to tail and down leg, then show looking in ears and show teeth. Dog must be comfortable and not struggling.
- AWAY** Demonstrate that your dog can remain calm while another person holds the leash while handler goes ten feet away for 30 seconds. This is emergency preparedness skill.
- GREET** Demonstrate that your dog can remain calm while Handler greets a person. Show a walking up to person, a brief greeting and walking away.
- HELLO** Demonstrate that your dog can remain calm when a new person greets your dog. Dog must keep four feet on the floor.
- STAY-1** Demonstrate that your dog can stay (Sit or Down) while the handler walks around the dog in a full circle, before the dog is released.
- STAY-2** Demonstrate that your dog can stay Stay for 30 seconds. Handler will cue the Stay and go to end of the leash for 30 seconds & return to the dog.
- LOOSE LEASH** Demonstrate that your dog can Loose Leash walk past food or toy distraction, placed within 5ft of the dogs path. Leash must remain loose.
- LEAVE IT** Demonstrate that your dog can Leave it, by placing food within your dogs reach, show 5 seconds of leave it.
- CRATE** Demonstrate that your dog can go into a crate or expen and be relaxed. 30 seconds or photo sleeping is accepted for relaxed.
- WALK ON** Demonstrate that your dog can walk past other dog(s) on leash and remain calm. (No barking, lunging, pulling)

ASSOCIATES

- HEEL SQUARE** Demonstrate Heel in a Clockwise Square Pattern. Show at least 10 steps on each side of the square.
- HEEL DISTRACTIONS** Demonstrate a Heel of at least 30ft, walking past moving distractions (people, cars, dogs, kids etc).
- FIND HEEL** Demonstrate that your dog can Find Heel from three feet away. You may use a cookie toss, station, or stay to achieve distance. Cue your dog to "heel" and show that they can get into a left side heel position, within 45 degrees.
- FIND FRONT** Demonstrate that your dog can find Front from three feet away. You may use a cookie toss, station, or stay to achieve distance. Cue your dog to "front" and show that they can get into a front position, within 45 degrees.
- EXAM** Demonstrate that your dog allows an exam. Show someone else running a hand from neck to tail and down leg, then show looking in ears and lifting a paw. Dog must show they are comfortable and not struggling.
- POSITIONS** Demonstrate that your dog can Sit, Down & Stand on Cue, Verbal or Physical, in Front Position
- AROUND** Demonstrate three steps in Heel, pause, then dog goes around handler clockwise to finish in Heel position.
- PIVOT** Demonstrate a Half Pivot with Dog In Heel Position. 180 Pivot (Half Circle) Counterclockwise, Handlers feet remain in place.
- RECALL** Demonstrate with your dog starting in Heel position, Stay(Leave your dog) go 6ft, face dog, pause 10 seconds, recall the dog to heel position.
- Heel 360** Demonstrate Heeling for 5 steps, perform 360 Left circle, Heel 5 more steps.

BACHELOR

- LEFT U-TURN** Demonstrate Heeling 5 steps, make a Left U-turn, heel five steps.
- TURNS** Demonstrate Heeling 3 Steps forward, make a 90 degree Left Turn, continue 3 Steps then make a Right Turn and continue 3 Steps.
- FIGURE 8** Demonstrate Heeling in Figure Eight around two uprights or cones.
- WEAVE** Demonstrate Heeling weave around three cones, with 1st cone on left side.
- 270 LEFT** Demonstrate Heeling 5 steps forward then perform a 270 loop to the left and continue in heel 3 steps.
- HEEL TO SIDE** Demonstrate Heel to side.
Dog starts in Heel(left) Position and swings to Side(right) Position.
- SIDE TO HEEL** Demonstrate Side to Heel.
Dog starts in Side(right) Position and swings to Heel(left) Position.
- FRONT TO HEEL** Demonstrate Front to Heel.
Dog starts in Front/Center position, and swings into Heel (left) Position.
- FRONT TO SIDE** Demonstrate Front to Side.
Dog starts in Front/Center position, and swings to Side (right) Position.
- HEEL TO FRONT** Demonstrate Heel to Front
Dog starts in Heel (left) Position and swings to Front Position.
- HEEL TO FRONT** Demonstrate Side to Front
Dog starts in Side(right) Position and swings to Front Position.

MASTERS

- BACK UP** Demonstrate dog backing up away from handler.(3Ft) (to a target ok)
- SEND MARK** Demonstrate sending the dog to a Target Mark, 5Ft Away, stay 3 seconds
- SEND AROUND** Demonstrate sending the dog around an Upright or Cone, 5Ft away
- SEND JUMP** Demonstrate sending the dog over a Jump that is 5Ft away, dog returns to handler, into heel position.
- RECALL JUMP** Demonstrate by having Dog Stay, While handler walks Past a Jump (5-10Ft past), Handler turns to Face Dog, then Recalls the dog Over the Jump, To Heel Position
- RECALL** Demonstrate with dog in sit or down, Leave your dog, handler goes 10 ft, turns to face dog, pause, then Recalls to Front position, pause then finish in Heel position.
- POSITIONS** Demonstrate Sit, Down, Stand, in Heel Position, Verbal Cue Only
- FETCH FRONT** Demonstrate with dog starting in Heel Position, Dog will Fetch Object To Front Position (Item can be thrown or pre placed)
- FETCH HEEL** Demonstrate with dog starting in Heel Position, Dog will Fetch Object To Heel Position (Item can be thrown or pre placed)
- MOVING** Demonstrate a moving Down or Sit. Heel 5 steps, ask the dog to down or sit while handler continues another 5 steps, then turn face dog, Recall to Heel or Front
- MID DOWN** Demonstrate place dog in sit stay, Handler Leaves dog, 10 or more steps away, turns to face dog, Recalls the dog, Dog performs a Down, at mid distance, pause, Recall to Heel or front. (Must be at least 1/3 distance away)
- ABOUT TURN** Demonstrate Heeling 5 steps, then perform an About turn, Heel another 5 steps (Dog in starts in heel, goes around handler as handler turns, and finishes in heel)
- BACKWARDS** Demonstrate with dog in Heel Position take 3 steps backwards, dog is to move with the handler.
- SIDE STEP** Demonstrate with dog in Heel Position, take 3 side steps to the right, dog to move with the handler.
- PIVOT 360** Demonstrate with dog in Heel Position, Pivot 360 together counterclockwise (Handlers feet remain in place)

PhD

Demonstrate each section in one uncut video, as a routine.
Memorized - No Visible Signage

- STAY-1** Demonstrate that your dog can stay (Sit or Down). Dog in Heel Position, handler walks around the dog in a full circle, returning to heel.
- HEEL TO FRONT** Demonstrate Heel to Front
Dog starts in Heel (left) Position and swings to Front Position.
- POSITIONS** Demonstrate that your dog can Sit, Down & Stand on Cue, Verbal or Physical, in Front Position
- FRONT TO HEEL** Demonstrate Front to Heel.
Dog starts in Front/Center position, and swings into Heel (left) Position.
- PIVOT 360** Demonstrate with dog in Heel Position, Pivot 360 together counterclockwise (Handlers feet remain in place)
- AROUND** Demonstrate three steps in Heel, Halt, then dog goes around handler clockwise to finish in Heel position. (Halt is any position: sit, down, stand)

- MOVING** Demonstrate a moving Down or Sit. Heel 5 steps, ask the dog to down or sit while handler continues another 5 steps, then turn face dog, Recall to Front.
- FRONT TO SIDE** Demonstrate Front to Side.
Dog starts in Front/Center position, and swings to Side (right) Position.
- SIDE TO HEEL** Demonstrate Side to Heel.
Dog starts in Side(right) Position and swings to Heel(left) Position.
- BACKWARDS** Demonstrate with dog in Heel Position take 3 steps backwards, dog is to move with the handler.
- SIDE STEP** Demonstrate with dog in Heel Position, take 3 side steps to the right, dog to move with the handler.
- ABOUT TURN** Demonstrate Heeling 5 steps, then perform an About turn, Heel another 5 steps (Dog in starts in heel, goes around handler as handler turns, and finishes in heel)
- RECALL** Demonstrate with your dog starting in Heel position, Stay(Leave your dog) go 6ft, face dog, pause 10 seconds, recall the dog to heel position.
